

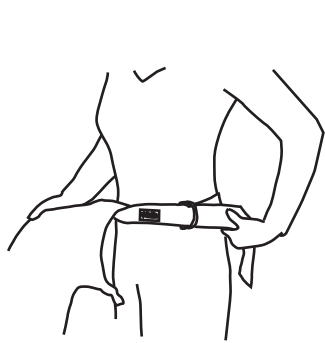

Instructions for use of your Belle Front Baby Carrier

We suggest you try your Belle first with a life-size baby doll or similarly sized stuffed animal.



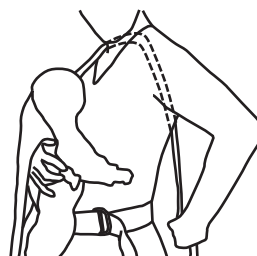
1 Secure the waistbelt around the waist so that the label faces out. Run the waistbelt through both rings and then back through the top ring and tighten.



2 Position your baby against your abdomen so the waist belt and one of your hands support him.



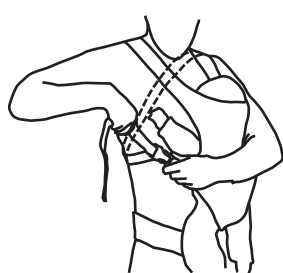
3 Lay one strap over your shoulder.



4 With the opposite hand, reach behind your back, grab the strap, cross it to the opposite side, and buckle.

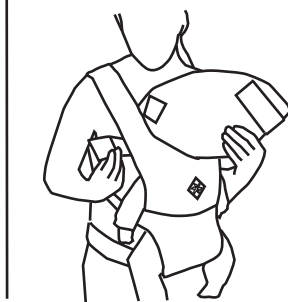


5 Place the other strap over your shoulder, cross it to the other buckle and attach.

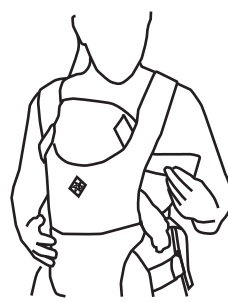


6 Adjust the tension on the straps so that your baby is securely against you.

head support panel



1 Position panel with straps facing out and velcro tabs toward top of panel. Run panel straps under shoulder straps.



2 Attach velcro then slide panel down until it stops, tucking bottom of panel inside top of carrier.

Suggestions

- The Belle is ideal for babies that weigh 8 - 30 lbs.
- The Belle works great for babies facing in or out. The outward facing position works best when the baby can hold his own head up safely.
- Tighten the waist belt with medium tension to lower your inward facing baby in the carrier and achieve head support. • Pull the waist belt tighter to raise your outward facing baby in the carrier and keep the baby's chin above the top edge. • If the baby's chin needs additional clearance over the top edge of the carrier, turn each shoulder strap out one full turn before connecting it to the side buckle. This "roll method" will fold the top edge of the carrier lower.
- During extended use, have a small soft blanket that you can fold up in various ways to help your baby's head stay comfortable in the carrier.



Warnings

- Never undo the waistbelt until your baby is safely removed from carrier.
- Do not use carrier on your side or back.
- Inspect the buckles, webbing and fabric for defects.

Common Sense Precautions

- Do not cook or use sharp objects while wearing carrier.
- Do not drive a motorized vehicle or ride a bicycle while using carrier.
- Do not engage in activities that might jar or bounce your baby while using carrier.
- Take special care to avoid trip or fall hazards while using carrier.
